King's Prepare for Postgraduate Scholarships Terms & Conditions 2025

Scholarship Details

The King's Prepare for Postgraduate Scholarships offer up to nine awards of £950 per recipient. These awards will be granted one per faculty for students who hold an offer for postgraduate studies at King's College London and want to undertake the King's Prepare for Postgraduate programme before commencing their postgraduate studies.

There are nine faculties at King's College London and there will be one Prepare for Postgraduate scholarship available for each faculty listed below:

- Faculty of Arts & Humanities (A&H)
- Faculty of Dentistry, Oral & Craniofacial Sciences (DOCS)
- Faculty of Law (DPSoL)
- Faculty of Life Sciences & Medicine (LSM)
- Faculty of Natural, Mathematical & Engineering Sciences (NMES)
- Faculty of Nursing, Midwifery & Palliative Care (NMPC)
- Faculty of Social Science & Public Policy (SSPP)
- Institute of Psychiatry, Psychology & Neuroscience (IoPPN)
- King's Business School (KBS)

Applicants must hold an offer to study on a King's College London Postgraduate Taught (PGT) or Postgraduate Research (PGR) programme to be eligible to apply for the scholarships. Applicants must be starting their studies in the 2025/26 academic year.

The prize of £950 is given toward the tuition fee of the Prepare for Postgraduate programme, reducing the cost to the student to £1000. No cash alternative is offered. If a student does not enrol on the Prepare for Postgraduate programme, then the prize is withdrawn. The scholarship is only available to students on a King's Prepare for Postgraduate programme and is not transferable to any other programme of study at King's College London.

Scholarship recipients will also be required to provide one written and one video testimonial about their time studying on King's Prepare for Postgraduate programme (once enrolled).

Am I eligible for the King's Prepare for Postgraduate Scholarship?

To be eligible* to apply for the King's Prepare for Postgraduate Scholarship, you must:

• Have submitted a completed application to your chosen King's Postgraduate Taught degree or Postgraduate Research degree for the academic year 2025/26.

- Be legally allowed to study in the United Kingdom (i.e. not restricted from entering the UK or from applying for a study visa).
- Hold an offer to study on a King's Postgraduate Taught or Postgraduate Research degree by the time the scholarship applications are reviewed.
- Meet the entry requirements for your chosen King's Postgraduate programme.

*Please note that being eligible does not mean an automatic entitlement to a scholarship, as final selection by committee is based upon your video submission.

How do I apply for a King's Prepare for Postgraduate Scholarship?

Please upload your one-minute video entitled **'How the Prepare for Postgraduate programme at King's will support my academic and professional goals.'** via the <u>application form</u> by 9:00 GMT Monday 7th July 2025.

The file name of your video needs to include your:

- 1. King's Student Number
- 2. First name and last name
- 3. The name of the degree
- 4. The short name of the faculty, as indicated in brackets in the above faculty list

For example: 1809876-John Smith-Comparative_Literature_MA-AH

On the <u>King's Prepare for Postgraduate Scholarship application form</u>, you will also be asked to fill in your first name, last name and email address before you can upload your video.

NOTE: Please make sure you use the same email address as you have used in King's Apply for your King's Postgraduate application so we can match your scholarship video submission with your programme application.

What are we looking for in your video?

• A clear and fluent style, demonstrating your enthusiasm for postgraduate study and the PfP programme.

• A well-structured presentation, clearly explaining how the PfP programme will support you in your academic and professional goals.

Important information

- 1. The application deadline is 9:00 BST, Monday 7th July 2025.
- 2. The offer of a scholarship is provisional upon the offer holder accepting and enrolling on the King's Prepare for Postgraduate programme by the enrolment deadline for the start of the programme in 2025.
- 3. Applicants who have been selected for the scholarship will be informed by 17:00 BST, Monday 14th July 2025. Please note that only successful applicants will be contacted and unfortunately, we are not able to give feedback on unsuccessful applicants.
- 4. The award is not a cash payment to the recipient. The amount is automatically deducted from the total tuition fee for the King's Prepare for Postgraduate programme.
- 5. Scholarship recipients agree to King's Foundations and/or King's College London using:
 - a. Their video submissions for promotional purposes
 - b. An image of the recipient in promotional materials
 - c. Their written and video testimonial for promotional purposes
- 8. The selection panel will consist of a group of academics and professional services staff from King's College London. All decisions of the panel are final.
